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Making the most of Medicare

Oct. 21, 2015 — Tarrant County residents eligible (or soon to become eligible) for Medicare are invited to attend a free information session designed to help older adults make the most of their Medicare benefits and the services available at JPS Health Network.

JPS provides care for Tarrant County residents across the lifespan, from unexpected emergencies to preventive care, at John Peter Smith Hospital in Fort Worth and in clinics throughout the county.

JPS accepts Medicare, and has a special program that can help eligible seniors with expenses that Medicare may not cover, such as the prescription drug coverage Part D coverage gap (better known as the “donut hole.”)
