# Scrub Guidelines



## Scrub Tops

- Piping has to be a solid color.

## Undershirts for Nurses, Techs, and Unit Clerks

- Solid white, black, or matching scrub top color
- No lace
- No piping
- No visible logo/writings/letters

## Designated Types of Jackets When Working in Patient Care Areas

- No outside logos
- No fleece jacket
- No hoodie
- Approved colors: galaxy blue, white, and black or matching scrub top color
- Seasonal scrub jackets for the entire month of November and December

## JPS Shirts

- No t-shirts as outerwear or under a jacket at work
- No JPS logo shirts during patient care work hours. JPS logo shirts can be worn for training, meetings, etc.

## Tattoos or Body Art

- Refer to HR 1801 Standards of Appearance Procedure

## Visible Body Piercings

- Visible body piercings, other than earrings, are not allowed in the workplace
