Sizing Chart Guide for Handmade Items

Hats

Baby	Preemie	12" x 4.5"
	Newborn	13" x 6"
Adult	Small	22" x 9"
	Medium	23.5" x 10.5"
	Large	24.5" x 11"

Scarves

Women	4.5" - 8" x 64" - 69"
Men	4.5" - 8" x 67" - 75"

Blankets

Baby	Receiving	36" x 36"
	Preemie	18" x 18"
	Baby	36" x 36" square or 36" - 38" x 40" - 42" Knitted and crochet blankets must be 36" square or slightly larger.
Adult	Lap	39" x 48"
	Throw	52" x 60"
	Twin	60" X 75"

Other Items

Lovey	10" x 10" or 12" x 12"
Resolution Squares	12" x 16" (no batting needed) Please use appropriate fabric, as these are for grieving parents.
Ostomy Bag Covers	The ostomy bag cover is 5 5/8" x 9 1/2". The opening can range from 1 3/4" to 2 3/4", so it may need to be adjustable. A sample is available in our office for your reference. Click here for a link to a pattern.

Reminders

- Fleece items are not accepted in the NICU or ICU. However, they are accepted in all other units for babies and adults.
- Any crocheted or knitted blankets cannot be given to preemies in the NICU, so make sure they are sized according to the knitted or crocheted baby blanket chart listed.
- Knitted and crocheted blankets are given to new moms upon discharge.
- Think about a new mom receiving a blanket for their baby - use children-friendly colors and patterns.
- Please wash all quilts and blankets before donating them.
